



COASTAL TEA TREE

(*Leptospermum laevigatum*)

DATA DETAILS

The newest member of our Tasmanian native essential oil portfolio is Coastal Tea Tree, a unique variety of the myrtle family *Leptospermum*. Although it isn't as widely known as its *Leptospermum* cousins such as Manuka and Lemon Tea Tree, the oil found in its leaves is just as aromatic and effective with many interesting uses.

Our Coastal Tea Tree is sourced from wild-crafted stock found in the pristine coastal dune environment of Tasmania's Flinders Island. The leaves and branchlets of this tall bushy shrub are steam-distilled, producing an essential oil that boasts a sweet earthy scent with light woody and citrus tones.



The essential oil from Coastal Tea Tree has a well-rounded terpene profile due to its composition which contains constituents such as alpha-pinene, eudesmols, limonene and elemol, to name a few. These compounds have a range of beneficial properties including anti-inflammatory, anti-bacterial and anti-viral. Coastal Tea Tree oil is therefore ideal for use in therapeutic settings such as spas and massage rooms, and in aromatherapy applications for overall well-being, reducing stress and improving respiratory function.
